## Securely Attached


- ego resiliency
- self esteem
- independence
- respond positively to others
- more longer lasting relationships
- EMPATHY especially for peers in distress

### Insecurely Attached

- Lying, stealing and bullying
- Unable to contain emotions, more likely to be targeted and bullied
- More short term-thinking, compromised advanced judgment

#### More than twice as likely to have ACE score of 3 or higher



# DOXIC SHAME Low SES people have more shame Shame is toxic and demoralizing Internalization of shame precludes understanding of oppression The "trick" is to make people ashamed of the injuries inflicted upon them



Dominant monkeys had more dopamine AND were less likely to use cocaine Subordinates died earlier, with gastric ulcers, enlarged adrenals, parts of hippocampus destroyed.


