## Aging Population & Seniors

- Constant thoughts of gambling
- Borrowing money
- Selling personal items
- Irritability, restlessness, withdrawal
- Delay payment of bills
- Loss of pension benefits
- Loss of social security benefits
- Neglecting household duties
- Decline in personal hygiene
- Decline in health
- Alienation from family and friends
- Inability to cut back / stop gambling
- Extreme guilt or shame
- Disappear for long periods of time
- Suicidal thoughts
